

Documenting patient delivered partner therapy (PDPT)

The autofill (Best Practice) or management/comment (Medical Director) shortcut function in your medical practice software can be used to quickly insert information about chlamydia management and patient delivered partner therapy into patient notes during a consult.

You can tailor the specific text to your own needs. Some suggestions for patient delivered partner therapy autofill text are provided below.
