

Documenting a chlamydia consultation

The autofill (Best Practice) or management/comment (Medical Director) shortcut function in your medical practice software can be used to quickly insert information about chlamydia management into patient notes during a consult.

You can tailor the specific text to your own needs. Some suggestions for chlamydia management autofill text are provided below.
